

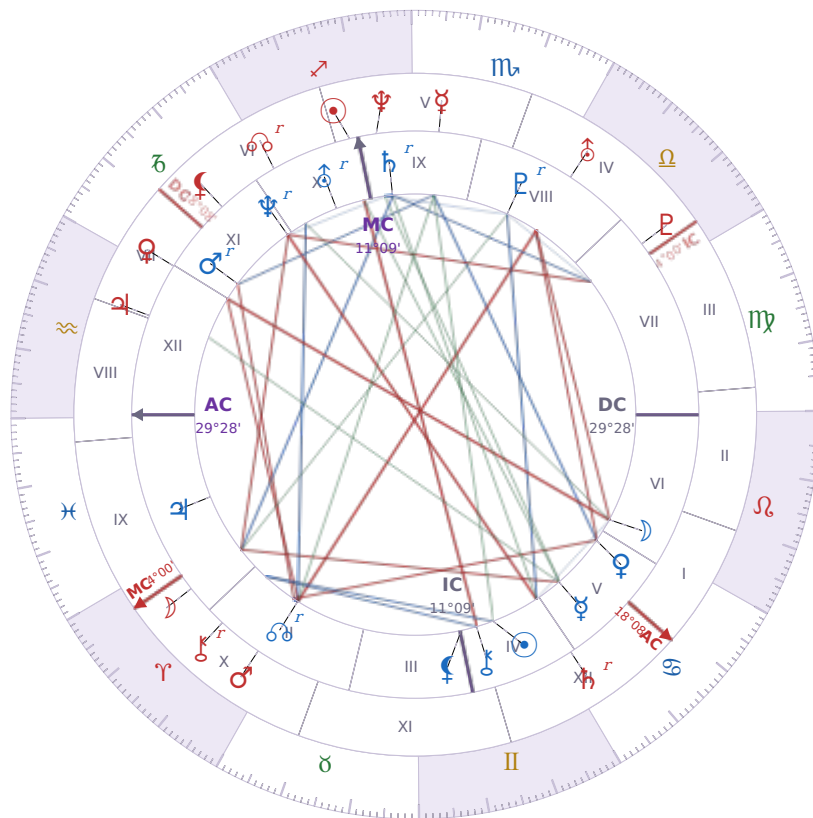

SUN SIGNS COMPATIBILITY

The opposition creates both attraction and friction: Gemini finds Sagittarius dogmatic, Sagittarius finds Gemini scattered. ☉ Shia's Sun in Gemini → H12 · Tyra

Shia's *Sun* falls in Tyra's twelfth house, the area of hidden life, solitude, and the unconscious. This is one of the most complex and deeply felt overlays in synastry. Shia has a way of **reaching parts of Tyra that Tyra doesn't ordinarily show** — Shia sees through Tyra's public persona and into something more private and essential. This can feel both profoundly intimate and unsettling. The relationship has a quality of the sacred and the difficult simultaneously.

☾ Shia's Moon in Leo → H1 · Tyra

Shia's *Moon* falls in Tyra's first house, placing Shia's emotional world directly in contact with how Tyra presents to others. Shia is deeply attuned to Tyra's moods and personal energy — in Shia's presence Tyra may feel unusually understood or, at times, emotionally exposed. **Shia brings nurturing, warmth, and instinctive care to Tyra's sense of self**, making this one of the most emotionally resonant placements in synastry. Tyra often feels most themselves when Shia is nearby.

☉ Tyra's Sun in Sagittarius → H10 · Shia
