



FULL MOON IN VIRGO · SUNDAY, 9 MARCH 2031

## Leo

*This ritual is for money, income, and material security.*

Security is not luck — it is a relationship you build slowly, with attention, the way a forest grows.

### PREPARATION

Face north. Clear and clean the surface in front of you as thoroughly as you can — material intentions root best in physical order, and this act of clearing is itself a kind of claim on abundance. Silence everything that buzzes or beeps. Pour a glass of something rich — red wine, dark tea, anything with weight to it — hold the glass in your stronger hand, feel its solidity, and take one deliberate sip before setting it down. Close your eyes and imagine your material life exactly as you want it: the number in your account, the feeling of paying something without flinching, the quiet confidence of a person who is not afraid of their own finances — make it concrete, make it specific, let your body know what security actually feels like. Open your eyes only when that feeling is as real as the glass beside you. The ritual begins now.

### THE RITUAL

Light the **gold candle** and let its warm, metallic light fill the space with the feeling of something already accumulated.

Hold the **pyrite** in both hands and press your thumbs into its surface as you name — out loud, specifically — the **financial goal or income stream** you are growing under this full moon in *Virgo*.

Light the **frankincense** resin or incense and pass the **pyrite** slowly through its smoke three times, as though you are polishing the intention until it shines.

Set the **pyrite** directly in front of the **gold candle** and sit with it quietly for several minutes, letting the image of your **material stability fully formed** become familiar rather than foreign to you.

Close the ritual by placing one hand over the **pyrite** without lifting it, pressing lightly, and saying aloud once: "**This is already in motion.**"

pyrite

frankincense
