



FULL MOON IN VIRGO · TUESDAY, 12 FEBRUARY 2036

Scorpio

This ritual is for friendships, community, and future goals.

The future you are building does not exist in isolation — it takes its shape from the hands that reach toward it with yours.

PREPARATION

Face south. Arrange the space with intention — bring in anything that reminds you of people who have stood beside you, a photograph, a small gift, a note — because this ritual is built on the understanding that you do not build the future alone. Silence your devices and let the room hold only you and the echoes of your people. Pour something that feels like a toast — wine is right, something you would raise toward others — hold the glass up briefly before drinking, as though making a silent pledge, then take one sip. Close your eyes and see your community as it could be at its fullest: the people around a table with you, the collaborators, the friends who challenge and sustain you, the version of your future that is already being built in conversations you have not yet had — see their faces, feel the warmth of the circle. Open your eyes when the image is vivid. The ritual begins now.

THE RITUAL

Light the **black candle** and let its quiet authority remind you that clarity about where you are going is not arrogance — it is necessary.

Light a small piece of **myrrh** incense or resin and let its ancient, resinous smoke move through the room, carrying with it the message that **you are calling your people forward with you**.

Hold the **obsidian** in both hands and name, one by one, up to three people in your community whose presence **genuinely serves the future you are building** under this full moon in *Virgo*.

Pass the **obsidian** through the **myrrh** smoke slowly, sealing those names and that vision into the stone, then set it in a place where you will see it in the days ahead.

Face the flame of the **black candle** directly, hold eye contact with it for ten full breaths, and **commit to one concrete action you will take this week** toward the future you named tonight.
